- 1 The highest peak in Hong Kong, with an altitude of about **【A】** metres, is called **【B】** . It is located approximately at the geographical centre of the New Territories and is made up entirely of **【C】** rocks.

- 2 Hong Kong got its raw water from two sources: rainfall collected in the local catchments & stored in **【A】** and supply from the **【B】** in Guangdong, providing respectively 20 per cent and 80 per cent of the water required for the territory.

- 3 **【A】** Reservoir is Hong Kong's first reservoir. It was completed in 1863 and was the major source of fresh water supply for the Hong Kong Island at the time.

- 4 The **【A】** was signed by the Prime Ministers of the People's Republic of China (PRC) and the United Kingdom (UK) governments on 19 December **【B】** in Beijing. In the Joint Declaration, the UK Government declared that it would hand over Hong Kong to the PRC with effect from **【C】** , making Hong Kong a **【D】** of the PRC.
