# Daegu Yangnyeongsi (early May)

At Daegu Yangnyeongsi 3, a herbal medicine market that has 361 years of history, the 650-meter-long Namseong-ro street is lined with some 350 Korean herbal medicine shops or restaurants that serve dishes with herbal ingredients. The Daegu Yangnyeongsi Herbal Medicine Festival is held every early May to allow visitors to experience traditional Korean medical and herbal medicines for free.

#### Daegu Chimac Festival (17 – 21 July)

The biggest festive event in Daegu, the Daegu Chimac Festival 4, which has attracted over 1 million visitors each

year since 2016, is celebrated with fried chicken and beer at Duryu Park every summer. Foodies can binge on signature fried chicken of different famous restaurant chains in Korea at one go, not to mention various brands of beer, funny DIY workshops, flea market bargains and stellar cultural performances that are on offer for the visitors to enjoy!
