議會正為未來做好準備 TIC priming itself for future

議會已成立專責小組,以探討將來在新監管制度下的角色及發展。

The TIC has set up a task force to study its future role and development under the new regulatory regime.

年十二月,政府宣佈將成立法定機構全面監管旅遊業,並預計過渡期至少要三年。在這期間最重要的事情,當然是持續的妥善監管,以及最終把監管權力順利轉移給新監管機構。

新監管制度實施後,議會就不再是自律監管機構,日後將擔當甚麼角色,有甚麼架構,與新監管機構、政府及其他旅遊組織的關係如何,在在都必須深思細想。

有鑒於此,理事會今年一月成立了「議會持續 發展專責小組」,成員包括理事會的執事人員、八 個屬會代表、業界選舉產生理事及業外獨立理事。 In December last year, the Government announced that a statutory body would be established to take full charge of the regulation of the tourism sector, with the transition period estimated to last for at least three years. What is most important during this period are continuation of effective regulation, and eventually, a smooth transfer of regulatory powers to the new regulatory body.

As the TIC will no longer be a self-regulatory body when the new regulatory system is implemented, it needs to think long and hard about its future role, structure, and relations with the new regulatory body, the Government and other travel organisations.

In view of this, the TIC Board set up in January this year the Task Force on the Sustainable Development of the TIC, composed of all office bearers, representatives of the eight Association Members, elected trade directors and non-trade independent directors.

Three subgroups under the Task Force are now studying them. Their views will then be consolidated by the Task Force, which will compile a detailed proposal for the Board to map out a specific development plan for the TIC.

No matter what the TIC will pursue in the future, its only goal is to work for the benefit of its members and the travel agent industry. To achieve this goal, what the TIC needs most is certainly the continuous support of its members.
