A/s: passport validity requirement for travellers visiting France

Dear Mr Tung,

Thank you for your letter dated on 1st April 2015.

The Consulate General of France has the honour to inform you that in order to be admitted to the French territory, an alien must be able to present a travel document (passport), recognized by French authorities, less than 10 years old, which validity must extend 3 months minimum beyond the visa's expiration date (or beyond the intended date of leaving the Schengen area if the passport holder benefits from the visa exemption scheme).
